Meeting called to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes and Financials

Trustees discussed the pros and cons but thought it could be dangerous without having lines painted on the road to show where the road ended and the berm began. No action taken.

Mr. Goddard said he is willing to talk to Mr. Spence (a neighbor) about taking care of it for her since the lady was willing to pay \$50/hour.
